

Call for Application - Antall József Summer School 2015

6 July – 17 July 2015

Organised by the Antall József Knowledge Centre annually, the Antall József Summer School focuses on the East-Central European region, paying particular attention to the Visegrad Cooperation. During the twelve-day event, participants can listen to and attend lectures and seminars in English, which put under scrutiny the economic, political, foreign and security policy, and cultural relations of the Visegrad Group, as well as discuss the significance of tourism and the problems of sustainable development.

The 2015 event will open with lectures and workshops revolving around the V4 and Western Balkan relations, as well as the 20th anniversary of signing the Dayton Peace Agreement. On 21 November 1995, the parties involved in Europe's deadliest conflict since World War II signed the peace agreement at the Wright-Patterson air force base, Ohio.

Beyond the transmission of knowledge, our aim is to enhance **intercultural dialogue**. For this reason, we organise various trips and programmes including the **Visegrád trip**, the Multicultural Evening, a visit to the House of Terror Museum etc.
