General aspects

Competition procedure for associate professor position title is set up according to the University competition methodology for getting on undetermined period a vacant didactic position or researcher, within the University of Oradea (Annex n^o.9. approved in the University Governing Council session from 22.04.2013).

In the Faculty Council session from 10.03.2017, had been approved the contest opening in the second semester, academic year 2016 – 2017, for the following academic position: nr. 12, professional title of associate professor, within the EFSK Department.

Competition procedure

Competition for professional title of associate professor consist in the analysis of the competition dossier.

Competition commission for associate professor professional position, being composed according to art. 17 from methodology, is proceeding to ranking, taking into account the dispositions from art. 19 of the same methodology.

The competition commission assess the candidate from the perspective of the following aspects:

- a) the impact and relevance of candidate's scientific outcomes;
- b) the capacity of the candidate to guide students and young researchers;
- c) didactic competences of the candidate;
- d) candidate's capacity to transfer his/her knowledge and outcomes to economic or social environment or to disseminate his/her own scientific outcomes;
- e) candidate's capacity to work within a team and the efficiency of his/her scientific collaborations;
- g) candidate's capacity to coordinate research-development projects;
- h) professional background of the candidate in institutions, other than the one which opened the competition session for a professional title.
