<b>Description of contest procedure</b>	<p><b>1. For the position of Associate Professor, candidates, graduates of an accredited higher education institutions, have to meet the following criteria:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• hold a bachelor degree in Music, and are specialised according to the position's description</li> <li>• hold a PhD diploma (Doctor) in Music</li> <li>• meet the minimum of national standards for accessing the teaching position approved by the Ministry of Education,</li> <li>• The specific criteria of the Faculty of Arts are equal to the minimum of national standards for accessing the teaching position.</li> </ul> <p><b>2. The contest for the position of Associate Professor consists of analyzing the candidate's contest file and holding a public lecture as follows:</b></p> <p>a) The candidate's contest file is evaluated by the contest commission. The score is calculated by dividing the score obtained on the <i>Minimum standards verification sheet</i> by the minimum score demanded and multiplied with 10.</p> <p>b) The didactic / scientific lecture (course) in front of the students takes place in the presence of the contest commission. The lecture can be exemplified by a micro-recital containing at least 2 works from different stylistic periods of about 15-20 minutes. The evaluation is done by awarding points from 1 to 10. The minimum score for passing is 8 points.</p> <p>The topic of the didactic lecture is established by the president of the contest commission, after consulting its members, and is announced at least 3 working days prior on the contest's website. A questions session from the commission and the public is also mandatory included.</p> <p>Both examinations are scored by each member of the commission, then the average of the scores for each is made and the minimum criteria are verified. The final result is the sum of the scores given by the</p>

members of the commission on evidence.

**3. The contest committee for the position of Associate Professor composed according to The contest Methodology for the occupation of a didactic or scientific vacant position in the University of Oradea, proceeds to hierarchy, keeping into account the foresight of Appendixes no. 1-35 of *The order concerning minimal approved necessary and compulsory standards for giving didactic titles in the superior education and of conferring professional research-development degrees*, 4204 from 15 July 2013, published in MONITORUL OFICIAL NR. 440/18 July 2013 – the minimum standards for Music**

**The committee president draws a report concerning the contest, based on the appreciation noted by each member of the committee, respecting the candidates hierarchy decided by the committee; The report concerning the contest will be approved through committee's decision and signed by each of its members and by the president;**

**The committee president will transmit the contest report, the appreciation reviews of the committee and the original file of the candidate to the faculty/department management, respecting the previewed deadline for the contest;**

**The contest file will be sent, through the university head secretary, at the university Senate;**

**The contest report and the original file of the candidate will be sent by the University of Oradea to The Ministry of Education and Scientific Research and CNATDCU, within the term previewed in the contest enrollment.**

**Appeals:**

**Appeals will be exclusively submitted for inobservance of legal procedures;**

**If a candidate held elements that can prove the inobservance of the contest legal procedures, he or she can formulate an appeal within 3 working days from the result's communication;**

**The appeal will be addressed in written and it will be registered at the University of Oradea registration service; it will be solved by the contest committee.**
