1. Emergency kit for the dental office.
2. Questionnaire for assessing the general condition.
3. Organizations of dental care and dental ergonomiques.
4. Antibioprophylaxies in the dental office.
5. Conduct in the dental office againstvariousdiseases (diseases of the cardiovascular system, respiratory system, endocrine system and metabolism, kidney, digestive system, immune system, hematologicalmalignancies)
6. History of implantology (Ancient period, Medievalperiod, Foundationperiod, Premodernperiod, Modern period, Contemporaryperiod.)
7. Preimplantationanatomy (Upperjaw / maxilla, Mandible, Innervation of teeth and gums, Vascular system of maxillary and mandibular teeth, Lymphatic drainage of teeth and gums, Morpho-functional changes of the dento-maxillaryapparatus.)
8. Types of boneatrophy and their classification in implantology (Availablebone dimensions, Classification of partiallyedentulous arches in implantology, Classification of fullyedentulous arches in implantology.)
9. Bone density and itsrole in implantology (Classification and location of bonedensity in implantology, Radiologicalevaluation of bonedensity, Influence of bonedensity on mechanical stress transfer, Therapeutic plan according to bonedensity.)
10. Imaging evaluation in implantology (Orthopantomography, Retroalveolarradiography, Teleradiography, Scanning tomography, Nuclearmagneticresonance (NMR), Computer tomography (CT), Dental volumetrictomography (conebeam volume, conebeamcomputedtomography)).
11. Contraindications to implant insertion (General / systemiccontraindications, Local contraindications, Recommendedlaboratoryexaminations, Implant treatment of patients withsystemicdisorders)
12. Patient medication (Classes of antibiotics - pros and cons, Non-steroidal anti-inflammatorydrugs - NSAIDs, Glucocorticoids, Analgesics.)
13. Insertion of endosseous implants (Patient preparation, Anesthesia, Flap design, incision and take-off, Alveolarbonedrilling, Implant insertion, Suturing.)
14. Insertion of implants with PRP (Platelet Rich Plasma) (General, Millingwithoutcooling, Growthfactors, Method of obtaining and using PRGF, Applications of PRGF in oral surgery)
15. Bone grafts, guided tissue regeneration.
16. Sinus lift (Classification of boneatrophy in the posteriorjaw, Internal and external sinus lifting technique)
17. Implantation Impression (Indirect Impression, Direct Impression, ProstheticScrewingTechnique: Impression Protocol, ProstheticCementation Technique: Impression Protocol)
18. Occlusal Concepts (Proprioception, OverloadFactors and Effects on

Occlusion, Principles of Implant Occlusion, Clinical Applications.)

19. Dental miniimplants.

20. Periimplantdisease; Maintenance of works on implants (Osteointegration, Epitheliointegration, Evaluation of osteointegration, Ethiopathogenesis and microbiology, Diagnosis. Maintenance of works on implants.)

21. Notions of anatomy:jaw, mandible, infratemporalfossa, pterygopalatinefossa, trigeminal nerve.

22. Notions of physiology of nerve transmission, Anesthetic substances used in local anesthesia:Lidocaine, Mepivacaine, Articaine, Vasoconstrictor adjuvants: Adrenaline and Noradrenaline, Felipressin, Levonordefrin;

23. Instruments used for loco-regionalanesthesia, Techniques used in loco-regionalanesthesia:topicalanesthesia, local anesthesia by infiltration, dam anesthesia;

24. Peripheraltruncularanesthesia of the maxillarynerve:anesthesia of the supero-posterioralveolar nerves (at tuberosity), anesthesia of the nasopalatine nerve, anesthesia of the anterior palatine nerve, anesthesia of the supero-anterioralveolar nerves (at the infraorbitalhole);

25. Peripheraltruncalanesthesia in the mandible:anesthesia of the inferioraveolar nerve (in the Spixspine), anesthesia of the buccal nerve, anesthesia of the lingual nerve, anesthesia of the chin and incisor nerve (anesthesia in the chinhole), anesthesia of the masseter nerve, anesthesia of the superficial and deep cervical plexus;

26. Accidents and complications of loco-regionalanesthesia, Local accidents of locoregionalanesthesia: pain, vascularlesions, transient facial paresis, transient auriculo-temporal nerve paresis, oculardisorders, needle rupture;

27. Accidents and complications of loco-regionalanesthesia, Local complications of loco-regionalanesthesia:epithelial desquamation and ulceration of the mucosa, mucosalnecrosis, postanesthetic injections, persistent trismus, persistent paresthesias, postextractionalalveolitis.

28. Accidents and general complications of loco-regionalanesthesia:vaso-vagal syncope, carotid sinus syncope, orthostatic hypotension, allergic accidents, general accidents
