University of Belgrade, Technical Faculty in Bor, for the ninth time organizing Symposium "Recycling Technologies and Sustainable Development", with aim that follow the modern trends in the field of recycling and sustainable development. The Symposium is being organized annually, because theme and the actuality of our time, impose such a short period.

The 9th Symposium "Recycling Technologies and Sustainable Development" (9th SRTOR) aims at providing a forum for presentation and discussion of scientific and technical achievements by scientist, experts and experts and all those which inevitably touches this field during their activities.

9th SRTOR will be the occasion for business meetings of sponsors and exhibitors, which will be able to present the latest technological developments in the field of recycling and environmental protection. TIME AND VENUE:

The 9th Symposium „Recycling technologies and sustainable development“ (9. SRTOR), will be held from September 10-12, 2014 at Hotel "Srbija-TIS", Zaječar, Serbia. Zaječar, city at the crossroads and the river banks of Black and White Timok, is located 240 km from Belgrade, and just 11 km from the Bulgarian state border.

SYMPOSIUM PROGRAM:

The Symposium work will be organized in sessions, including plenary lectures, session lectures, oral and poster presentations. The plenary and session lectures will be given by invited lecturers.

SYMPOSIUM LANGUAGE:

The official Symposium language will be Serbian and English.

CALL FOR PAPERS:

The authors are kindly invited to submit their full-length papers (up to 6 pages including figures and tables), until June 30, 2014. The papers should be written in English and in accordance with the instructions available on the Symposium website.

The author(s) are responsible for the content or validity of papers. All papers will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. The Symposium Proceedings will include only the papers accepted by the Scientific Committee.

There is also an opportunity for the authors to publish their papers in the extended form in special issues of Journal of Recycling and Sustainable Development (<http://www.ror.tf.bor.ac.rs>), after reviewing and the appropriate revisions.

The journal issued annually and published scientific and technical papers in the field of recycling and sustainable development.

INSTRUCTION FOR AUTHORS:

Maximum length of papers is 6 pages (with enclosures) format A4 (210×297 mm). Margins are next: left 4.2 cm, right 4.2 cm, top 5 cm, bottom 5 cm. The papers should be prepared in MS Word for Windows format; Unicode font: Resavska BG and Resavska BG Sans (Multilanguage support); single spacing with the instructions which are given in the template document.

A paper should include the following parts: title, full names of the authors, abstract and the keywords, introduction, paragraphs (material and methods of work, results and discussion of the results), conclusion and list of references.

The manuscripts which are not prepared according to the instructions will be returned to authors for revision.

The student papers, where professors appear as authors, would not be considered for presentation to the Student Symposium, but same can be sent to 9th SRTOR.
