## **I. MISSION OF THE STUDY PROGRAMME (BIP) - Themes and Research Methods in the Field of History and Philology**

The mission of this 3 ECTS BIP program, *Themes and Research Methods in the Field of History and Philology* is to provide students with an interdisciplinary foundation in the themes and research methods of History and Philology. By integrating historical analysis and philological expertise, this study programme seeks to equip participants with the skills to critically engage with historical texts, languages, and cultural narratives across different periods and regions. The 3 ECTS BIP program zooms to facilitate an understanding of the interconnectedness between history and philology, allowing students to analyze texts and historical data with linguistic precision and cultural context.

The programme is for a good international collaboration that is essential for the professional and personal growth. We propose an online and physical collaboration between students of history and philology studies from three European universities. In the field of Higher Education, universities acknowledge the importance of addressing the international perspective on educational issues throughout the curriculum. There is a need for professionals to take an international perspective on national or local issues because our multicultural society and interconnected worlds are now a reality and fresh challenges lie ahead of us. It is necessary that students are prepared to deal with the various research methods and the only way to initiate this is to meet other students from different countries to exchange knowledge and views on topics in the field of history and philology.

## **II. OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY PROGRAMME BIP - Themes and Research Methods in the Field of History and Philology**

Within this program, we plan to present and use different research approaches, mainly promoting active learning and student participation. We plan to divide the participants of the three university in multinational groups. Before coming to Oradea each group will have to prepare some defined tasks connected with research methods and techniques on different subjects. The students will have to communicate online. The students will have to share responsibility and work together and discuss with experts during lectures and study visits to cultural organizations. We aim to include students from bachelor, master and PhD study level.

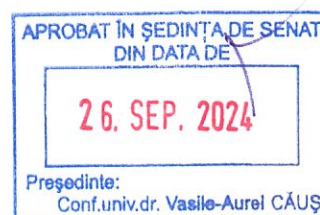
The programme is to promote the integration of historical inquiry and philological analysis, enabling students to understand and interpret historical texts, linguistic evolution, and cultural transformations through a combined approach.

These objectives are designed to provide a comprehensive framework for the programme, combining rigorous academic training with practical skills and international collaboration. They will ensure students gain a deep understanding of the research methods in history and philology while preparing them for future academic or professional pursuits. This will help to prepare students for further academic research or professional roles in fields related to history, linguistics, cultural heritage, and education, by cultivating both subject-specific expertise and transferable skills. The practical part is to improve students' ability to present research findings clearly and persuasively, both in written and oral forms, through presentations and collaborative discussions.

## **III. COMPETENCES THAT GRADUATES WILL OBTAIN UPON THE COMPLETION OF STUDIES**

### **Professional competences:**

- Establishing historical facts based on information from sources and from outside sources.



- Correct definition and presentation of the main concepts used in historical and philological studies, of the great stages and processes in human history, of the current state of historiography and of the fundamental methods of historical and philological research.
- Oral and written presentation, in Romanian, Spanish, Italian or in a language of international circulation, of specialized knowledge.
- The use of the basic concepts and methods of another humanistic science (philology), or of a border discipline between history and philology.
- Critical analysis of historical sources, by consciously combining knowledge from outside the sources and from the sources to (re)establish some historical facts and processes, contextualizing the existing value judgments regarding these historical facts and processes and correlation at an elementary level of the available information about the historical past with the problems present in the historiographical analyzes related to the respective era.
- The application of the notions and methods of another science (philology), or of a border discipline between history and philology, to the research of historical facts.
- Critical analysis of the sources and research approaches specific to a period or historical and societal issues

#### **Transversal competences**

- Completion of professional tasks on time, rigorously and responsibly, in conditions of efficiency and effectiveness, in compliance with the ethical principles of scientific activity, rigorous application of citation rules and rejection of plagiarism and other requirements.
- Application of group communication techniques and effective teamwork, assuming various roles.


