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#### SPECIFIC FACULTY COMPETITION PROCEDURE

# FOR OPEN-ENDED EMPLOYMENT TEACHING AND RESEARCH VACANCIES AT THE FACULTY OF SOCIAL AND HUMANISTIC SCIENCES



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#### I. GENERAL ASPECTS

#### Art. 1.

At the Faculty of Social and Humanistic Sciences, Departments of Psychology, Educational Sciences and Sociology-Social Work, all vacant teaching or research positions are filled for an indefinite period only through *public competition*, in accordance with:

- Law nr. 199/2023;
- HG 1339/2023 regarding the approval of the Competition Framework Methodology for filling vacant teaching and research positions in higher education;
- OM 6129/2016 regarding the approval of the minimum necessary and mandatory standards for conferring teaching titles in higher education, professional degrees of research and development, doctoral supervisors and habilitation certificates;
- Specific Standards regarding the external evaluation of academic quality for study programs in the bachelor and master fields related to specialized committees, approved by the ARACIS Council;
- Specific Faculty Competition Methodology for filling vacant teaching and research positions in the University of Oradea, approved by the University Senate;
- Criteria for competing on vacant teaching positions, approved by the Senate of the University of Oradea;
- this Specific Faculty Competition Procedure for filling vacancies by competition for an indefinite period;
  - other Normative Acts in force at the time of holding the competitions.

#### Art. 2. Posting of teaching positions for competition and registering candidates.

- **2.1.** The Faculty of Social and Humanistic Sciences can post for competition teaching and research positions in the fundamental fields *of Social Sciences*, approved by the Senate of the University of Oradea, depending on their development strategy and in compliance with the provisions of ARACIS standards regarding the percentage of tenured teachers in relation to all teaching positions.
- **2.2.** The vacancies are proposed by the director of the department/doctoral school in which the position is located, by written approval by the Department Council/ Doctoral School Council and by the Faculty Council.
- **2.3.** The list of positions proposed for filling by public competition is endorsed by the Faculty Council, approved by the Dean and submitted to the Board of Directors of the UO for approval, according to art. 139, letter d) of the Law on Higher Education nr. 199/2023.
- **2.4.** The public announcement of competitions for filling vacant teaching or research positions is made by the University of Oradea based on *Specific Competition Methodology for filling vacant teaching and research positions* and the *Calendar of competitions for positions published in the Official Gazette*.
- **2.5.** The registration for the competition for the vacant teaching positions is done by submitting the competition file to the Humanistic Resources Department of the University of Oradea. The competition file must be prepared in accordance with the List of documents required for registration in the competition and the criteria for filling teaching positions provided in Specific Competition Methodology for filling vacant teaching and research positions of the University of Oradea.

#### DEPARTMENT LEVEL PREPARATION OF JOB COMPETITIONS

**Art. 3.** The department directors will submit to the Faculty Council the committees proposed by the Department Council for conducting job competitions. These proposals will be centralized and approved in the Faculty Council meeting. The nominal composition of the competition committee, together with the endorsement of the Faculty Council, is transmitted to the University Senate and submitted for its approval. Following approval by the University Senate, the competition committee is appointed by the Rector.



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#### Art. 4. Competition Committee

- **4.1.** The composition of the competition committee is established after the publication of the vacancy notice, for each position posted for competition.
- **4.2.** The competition committee consists of 5 members, including its president, the specialists in the field of disciplines of the position posted for competition or in related fields. The composition of the competition committee includes at least 2 alternate members (one of whom is outside the UO, for the positions of professor or associate professor). If one of the committee members is unavailable to participate during the work of the committee, he/she will be replaced by his/her alternate, being appointed in accordance with the same procedure as the other members of the committee.
- **4.3.** The decisions of the competition committee are made by the open vote of the members. A decision of the committee is valid if it has obtained the vote of at least 3 members of the committee.
- **4.4.** The proceedings of the competition committee are led by the chairman of the committee.
- **4.5.** The members of the committee can be from inside or outside the UO, from Romania or from abroad.
- **4.6.** In order to fill a position of associate professor, full professor, scientific researcher 1<sup>st</sup> degree or scientific researcher 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, at least 3 members of the committee must be from outside the UO, from Romania or from abroad.
- **4.7.** The members of the competition committee must have a teaching or research title superior or at least equal to that of the teaching/ research position corresponding to the position posted for competition or, for the members from abroad, they should meet the minimum standards, corresponding to the teaching / research position related to the position posted for competition.
- **4.8.** For the sole purpose of participation in the competition committee, the equivalence of the teaching or research titles of the members from abroad with the teaching or research titles in Romania will be equated. Based on this equivalation the University Senate approves the nominal composition of the competition committee.
- **4.9.** The president of the competition committee may be:
  - a) the director of the department or the head of the doctoral school where the position is located;
  - b) the dean or vice-dean of the faculty in which the position is located;
  - c) a tenured teacher in the UO, specialist in the field of the position subjects or in a related field, delegated for this purpose by the vote of the department council, respectively of the faculty council organizing the competition.
- **4.10.** When appointing the president of the competition committee, an alternate president will also be appointed (who will also be able to act as an alternate member of the competition committee).



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#### II. REGISTRATION FOR THE COMPETITION

- **Art. 5.** In order to apply for the competition, candidates must meet the following minimum requirements and standards:
- **5.1.** For the position of teaching assistant or research assistant the following conditions are cumulatively required:
  - a) the candidate should hold a doctoral degree or be enrolled in a doctoral study program, without exceeding the maximum period of study, which includes extensions admissible according to the law;
  - b) the candidate should publish at least 1 paper (article, study), in extenso, in specialized journals or in volumes of national or international scientific events;
  - c) the candidate should meet other specific additional standards set out in Appendices 3.1 and 3.2 (as appropriate).
- **5.2**. <u>For the position of lecturer or 3<sup>rd</sup> degree scientific researcher</u> the following conditions are cumulatively required:
  - a) the candidate should hold a doctoral degree;
  - b) the candidate should publish at least 5 papers (articles, studies), in extenso, in specialized journals or in volumes of national or international scientific events;
  - c) the candidate should elaborate, at least in electronic format, a specialized teaching material, posted on the e-learning platform of the UO (e.uoradea.ro), in the field of the subjects of the position, or of a specialized book, in the field of the job;
  - d) the candidate should meet other additional standards, as set out in Appendices 3.1 and 3.2 (as appropriate).
- **5.3.** <u>In order to fill the position of associate professor or 2<sup>nd</sup> degree scientific researcher</u>, the following conditions are cumulatively required:
  - a) the candidate should hold a doctor's degree;
  - b) the candidate should meet the minimum national standards for the position of associate professor, standards approved according to art. 156 of the Higher Education Law no. 199/2023;
  - d) the candidate should meet other supplementary standards, as set out in Appendices 3.3 and 3.4 (as appropriate).
- **5.4.** <u>In order to occupy the position of full professor or 1<sup>st</sup> degree scientific researcher</u>, the following conditions must be cumulatively met:
  - a) the candidate should hold a doctor's degree;
  - b) the candidate should hold the habilitation certificate;
  - c) the candidate should meet the minimum standards for the position of full professor, standards approved according to art. 156 of the Higher Education Law nr. 199/2023;
  - d) the candidate should meet other supplementary standards, as set out in Appendices 3.3 and 3.4 (as appropriate).

#### DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO REGISTER FOR THE COMPETITION

- **Art. 6.** The registration for the competition for filling the teaching positions at the Departments within the Faculty of Social and Humanistic Sciences is done according to the provisions *of its Specific Competition Methodology for filling the vacant teaching and research positions in the University of Oradea, by submitting the registration file to the Humanistic Resources Department within the University of Oradea, directly or through postal or courier services that allow confirmation of postal receiving.*
- **Art. 7.** The competition file is put together by the candidate and it will include the self-assessment sheets for meeting the minimum national standards of the University of Oradea, respectively the specific requirements and criteria (Appendices 3.5, 3.6, 3.7, 3.8, according to each case).
- **Art. 8.** The competition file is submitted in a printed format, as well as on electronic support, with its entire content scanned. The list of papers, curriculum vitae and check sheet will be scanned as separate files, without



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exceeding 10 MB all together. The scanned documents will not show the candidate's personal data (photo, CNP, home address, signature etc.).

**Art. 9.** The fulfillment by a candidate of the legal conditions for submission to the competition is certified by the approval of the legal department of the U.O.

#### III. RUNNING THE COMPETITION

- **Art. 10.** The competition committee evaluates the candidates for the posted positions according to the following criteria:
  - a) the relevance and impact of the candidate's scientific results;
  - b) the candidate's ability to mentor students or young researchers;
  - c) the teaching skills of the candidate;
  - d) the candidate's ability to transfer his knowledge and results to the economic or social environment or to disseminate her/his own scientific results;
  - e) the candidate's ability to work in a team and the efficiency of his/her scientific collaborations, according to the specifics of the job field;
  - f) the candidate's ability to lead research and development projects;
  - g) the professional experience of the candidate in institutions other than the University of Oradea.
- **Art. 11.** If the position posted is assistant / lecturer / senior lecturer, the competition committee has the obligation to verify and ascertain, from a didactic and scientific relevance perspective, the fulfillment of the standards for occupying teaching positions, specific to the position, approved by the university senate, according to the law.
- **Art. 12.** If the position concerned is associate professor / full professor, the competition committee has the obligation to verify and ascertain the fulfillment, from a didactic and scientific relevance perspective, of the minimum standards and additional requirements by the candidate. The minimum standards and additional requirements may not derogate from the national minimum standards approved according to Article 156 para. (1) letter a) of the Law on Higher Education nr. 199/2023, as subsequently amended and supplemented.
- **Art. 13.** The candidate's professional skills are evaluated by the competition committee, based on the competition file and, additionally, by the following tests:
- **13.1** Competition for occupying a <u>teaching assistant / research assistant</u> position consists of a written test and a practical test (seminar, laboratory). The theme of the practical test is established by the president of the competition committee, in consultation with its members, and it is announced at least 3 working days before the test on the competition website, together with the day, time and place of the competition, thus inviting all candidates to participate at the competition tests.

The calculation of the score after analyzing the candidate's competition file is based on the indicators provided in the Grid for evaluating the candidates (Appendix 3.1 or 3.2, as appropriate).

- 13.2 In order to occupy a position of senior lecturer or 3<sup>rd</sup> degree scientific researcher, associate professor / 2<sup>nd</sup> degree scientific researcher and full professor / 1<sup>st</sup> degree scientific researcher, the competition tests are:
- (a) Teaching lecture this test must also include a questioning session from the committee. The topic of the teaching lecture is established by the president of the competition committee, in consultation with its members, and it is announced at least 3 working days before the test on the competition website, together with the day, time and place of the competition, thus inviting all candidates to take part at the competition tests. The lecture will be graded with marks from 1 to 10, being admitted 2 decimals.
- (b) The lecture on university career development, in which the candidate presents the most significant previous professional results and the university career development plan. This test must also include a questioning session. The lecture will be graded with marks from 1 to 10, being admitted 2 decimals.

The score resulted after the analysis of the candidate's competition file is based on the indicators provided in the grid for evaluating the candidates (Appendix 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, or 3.4, as the case may be).

Art 14

14.1. For each position, the competition committee decides on the hierarchy of candidates and nominates the



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candidate who obtained the best results.

- **14.2.** The president of the competition committee draws up a report (Appendix 5) on the competition, based on the appreciation reports (Appendix 4.1 or Appendix 4.2, as the case may be) drafted by each member of the competition committee and in accordance with the hierarchy of candidates as decided by the committee.
- **14.3**. The report on the competition is approved by the decision of the competition committee and it is signed by each of the members of the competition committee and by the president of the committee.
- **14.4.** The result of the competition shall be published, within 2 working days from the end of the competition, on the UO website.
- **14.5.** The president of the competition committee submits the report on it, approved by the decision of the committee, the assessments reports and the original file of the candidate to the faculty / department / center administration, meeting the deadline provided for the competition.
- **14.6.** The candidate may file a written appeal within 3 working days from the communication of the result and register it at the UO registry office. The appeal is resolved by a specially appointed committee, which cannot include the initial members of the competition committee.
- **Art.15.** This procedure completes with standards specific to the fields managed by the Faculty, *the Specific competition methodology for filling vacant teaching and research positions in the University of Oradea*, approved by the UO Senate and comes into force from the date of its approval in the University Senate.

# CRITERIA, PERFORMANCE INDICATORS AND MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR CONFERRING THE TEACHING TITLES OF ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR AND FULL PROFESSOR IN

### FIELD OF PSYCHOLOGY AND EDUCATIONAL SCIENCES, PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORT

### Definitions, conditions, procedures

- Only scientific achievements, i.e. elements of visibility and impact relevant to psychology, educational sciences, sport science and physical education respectively or in borderline fields shall be taken into account.
- Each publication falls under a single indicator, taking into account the classification most favorable to the candidate.
- Recognized International Databases (BDIs) are Web of Science (WoS) (formerly known as ISI), Scopus, PsycInfo, ERIC, PubMed/Medline, ERIH Plus/ERIH Int 1 – ERIH Int 2, DOAJ, Ebsco (Academic Search Premiere, SPORTDiscuss, etc.), ProQuest, ScienceDirect, SpringerLink, Wiley Online Library, Sage, Ovid/Informa, EducationalResearchAbstracts Online, HEDBIB, CrossRef or JSTOR.
- International conferences are scientific events that cumulatively meet at least four of the following criteria: (a) the conference is organized or co-organized by an international scientific/professional association or institution; (b) more than 50% of the members included in the Scientific Committee have institutional affiliation abroad; (c) the scientific program as well as the proceedings or abstracts are published in printed or electronic format in a foreign language of international circulation (English, French, German or Spanish); (d) the proceedings of the conference are conducted exclusively in a foreign language of international circulation; (e) more than 50% of participants with papers enrolled in the scientific program of the Conference have institutional affiliation abroad. Conferences that do not meet the minimum criteria to be classified as such will have the status of national conferences.
- BDI conferences or publications refer to those scientific events, respectively publications, indexed in one or more international databases recognized by these standards.
- Books, book chapters or collective volumes of conferences are classified in category A1 (publications published by internationally prestigious publishing houses), category A2 (publications published by publishing houses with recognized prestige) or category B (publications published by other recognized publishing houses). World Cat indexed publications in Karlsruhe Virtua lCatalog KVK (http://www.ubka.unikarlsruhe.de/kyk en.html) are classified A1 if they are found in at least 25 libraries of higher education institutions in other Member States of the European Union or in Member States of the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development. A2 or B indexed publications are those that have either appeared with one of the publishers mentioned in the following table or benefit from fulfilling the conditions of the complementary route. According to this route, a book / book chapter / volume is included in category A2 if it meets at least two criteria, respectively in category B if it meets at least one of the following criteria: (a) the publishing house where the publication appeared has at least one collection relevant to the fundamental field analyzed, with at least 10 scientific books published in the field in the last five years; (b) the publication under review is available in at least 5 libraries of higher education institutions in other Member States of the European Union or Member States of the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development, indexed in Karlsruhe Virtual Catalogue KVK(http://www.ubka.uni-karlsruhe.de/kvk\_en.html); (c) the publication under consideration has appeared in at least 800 printed copies, or in at least 500 printed



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copies if it can also be purchased in digital form; (d) the paper has accumulated at least 5 citations in Web of Science indexed publications. Publications published by classified publishers may receive a score corresponding to a higher category if they meet the criteria specified by the complementary route for that classification level. Publications that do not meet the minimum criteria to be classified shall not be scored. Publications published in multiple editions can be scored individually if changes / revisions are identified on a significant number of pages. Also, publications with different titles, but with similar content, can only be considered once. In these cases, the decision regarding the score awarded belongs to the members of the competition / habilitation committees.

- \* The categorization of publishers will be updated annually.
  - Educational policy/strategy analysis reports are classified into international reports and reports of national relevance. International reports cumulatively fulfil the following three criteria:(a)the report is drawn up at the request of a prestigious international organization and presented under the logo of that organization (e.g. UNICEF, UNESCO, World Bank, OECD, European Committee or its agencies, WHO, etc.); (b)the report is written entirely in a foreign language circulating internationally; (c) the analysis carried out on the issue under investigation is internationally relevant (e.g. cross-country comparisons are presented). National reports cumulatively fulfil two criteria: (a)the report is drafted at the request of an organization of national prestige and presented under the logo of that organization (e.g. Ministry of Education, Save the Children Organization, etc.), (b)the analysis carried out on the investigated issue is nationally relevant (e.g. comparisons are presented at the level of development regions or there are records of use at the level of public policies).
  - The grants considered in these standards refer to those contracts for granting financial assistance, obtained following a project competition, whose nominal value is at least 25,000 euros or its equivalent in lei or another currency. Grants are in turn ranked: (i) by type of competition (international vs. national); (ii)by main object of funding
  - (a) research of wide public relevance, grants financed, as a rule, by public agencies aimed at financing fundamental research or the RDI sector (research-development-innovation) (e.g. UEFISCDI, etc.); (b)research of specific relevance such as in grants awarded by profit-oriented companies, non-governmental associations, foundations, etc.; (c) institutional development projects (e.g. providing services to target group beneficiaries). By way of exception, the financial ceiling for research grants of broad public relevance, funded through national competitions prior to PNII (National Plan for Research and Development Innovation) does not apply. The members of the competition / habilitation committee may decide to classify institutional development grants in research grants, if proof of consistent research activities is provided through the respective grant.
  - Lead author refers to any of the following four types of authorship: (a) sole author; (b) the first author mentioned in the publication; (c) the corresponding author mentioned in the publication; (d) where it is



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explicitly stated in the publication that all authors make an equal contribution to the publication. In the case of physical education and sports, the last author mentioned may also have the status of main author.

- Co-author refers to any case other than those mentioned above (e.g. second author in an article, without him being a corresponding author or stating that all authors have an equal contribution).
- n indicates the number of authors of a publication.
- For a number of indicators (books, analysis reports, conferences, grants, etc.) a multiplication coefficient m will be applied where the calculation formula includes this coefficient. The values of *m* are: m=3, if the dotted indicator has a definite international relevance (Web of Science indexed journals; volumes published in A1 classified publishing houses; international conferences; research grants with wide public relevance obtained through international competition; international analysis reports, etc.);

m=1, if the dotted indicator has a national relevance – impact and prestige at national level (volumes published in publishing houses classified A2; national conferences; journals indexed in two recognized BDIs, other than WoS; research grants with wide public relevance obtained through national competition; national analysis reports, etc.);

m=0,5, if the dotted indicator has a secondary national relevance (volumes published in publishing houses classified B; journals indexed in a single recognized BDI other than WoS etc.)

A threshold p of relevance shall be established for the impact factor (IF) of the journals considered for indicators I1, I2, I5 and I6, which has the following values:

p=1.00 for the field of Psychology;

p=0.10 for the fields of Educational Sciences, respectively Physical Education and Sport

The author's contributions to Web of Science indexed journals are considered only from the moment they are published in Web of Science. The IF valid on the date of publication of the article in WoS will be taken into account.

- Minimum standards are grouped into two areas: scientific achievements, visibility and impact.
- In scientific achievements, the core indicators are differentiated to distinguish between significant contributions as lead author and significant contributions made as co-author.
- Each area has specific indicators and scores, reflected in several criteria to be achieved, with the mention that all these criteria must be met cumulatively in order to consider that the evaluated person meets the minimum standards for the reported position.

### Transitional provisions

1.Romanian journals that are not indexed in BDI recognized by this order, but which have been indexed in BD I recognized according to order 6560/2012, published in MO Part I on 27.12.2012, receive the status of Recognized Journals in a BDI (indicator I 11). This status is a transitional one, ending on 01.03.2018. For continued recognition after this date, journals must provide proof of inclusion in at least one database recognized by this order. All papers published until 01.03.2018 in such journals will continue to be scored in indicator I11 even after the expiration of the transition period. Papers published after the expiration date of the transition period, in the context of the failure of the indexation process in at least one BDI recognized by this order, will no longer be scored

2.In the field of psychology, until 01.03.2018 there is the possibility of compensating between them criteria C1, C2, C4 and C5, provided that their sum complies with the minimum total required by aggregating these criteria.

3.In the field of educational sciences, until 01.03.2018 there is a possibility to compensate criterion C5, respectively indicator I27 with points obtained in indicator I28.

4.In the field of education sciences, scores for indicator I1 shall be valid for two years from the entry into force of these rules. After this period, they will be adjusted upwards.

Minimum necessary and mandatory standards for conferring teaching titles in higher education and professional degrees of research and development in the subfields of SOCIOLOGY AND COMMUNICATION SCIENCES, POLITICAL SCIENCES AND INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS and ADMINISTRATIVE SCIENCES

#### (1) Definitions and conditions:

- 1. Only published works in the field of Social sciences, Humanistic and borderline fields shall be taken into consideration.
- 2. The books, volumes or dictionaries considered are those published by publishing houses with international prestige (category A1), or at publishing houses with recognized prestige (category A2), or which are present in at least 6 libraries in Worldcat.
- 3.Se considered as international languages: English, French, German, Italian and Spanish.
- 4.For certain categories of publications (see grid below), the multiplication coefficient m is applied, which has the following values: 2, if the publication appeared at a foreign publishing house with international peer review and is written in an international language;
- 1.5, if the publication is written in an international language, but has not appeared at a foreign publishing house with international peer review; 1, in the rest of the cases.
- 5. The recognized international databases are the following: ISI Web of Knowledge, SCOPUS, EBSCO, ProQuest, CEEOL, Ulrich, ERI1H, Index Copernicus, CSA, GESIS, IBSS; SAGE, OVID, ECOLIT, Psychlit, PubMEd, Elsevier, Springerlink, Persee, DOAJ, Jstor, SSRN, REPEC, Inform, Project MUSE, HEIN Online.
- 6. n indicates the number of authors of a publication of which the candidate is author or co-author.

  7. For the category of articles published in "ISI rated" journals, only those indexed in ISI Web of Kr.
- 7. For the category of articles published in "ISI rated" journals, only those indexed in ISI Web of Knowledge are taken into account, being mandatory to report the registration code of the article (WOS). The impact factor, where it exists, is that corresponding to the year in which the article was published [1]
- 8. A publication shall fall under a single indicator, taking into account the more favorable for the candidate.
