<b>Contest topics</b>	<b>Didactic lecture</b> (only for candidates coming from outside higher education) Public lecture on “Academic Career Development Plan” – presenting the most significant previous professional results and further academic career development plan.
<b>Description of contest procedure</b>	<p>The contest for University Professor tenure consists in the analysis of the candidate’s contest file and a public/didactic/scientific lecture.</p> <p>The public lecture lasts for minimum 45 minutes, in which the candidate presents his most significant professional results and his academic career development plan. This test also includes a compulsory session of questions from the examining commission and the audience.</p> <p>Candidates coming from outside higher education system must also deliver a lecture in front of students, in the presence of the contest commission. The topic of the lecture is to be announced to the candidates 48 hours before its delivery, by posting it on the web page of the Department and on the notice board of the Faculty.</p> <p>The examining commission for a University</p>

	Professor tenure contest, formed according to University of Oradea's own Contest Methodology for Vacant Teaching and Research Positions, will rank the candidates, also taking into account the provisions of Art. 22 of the same methodology.
<b>List of documents</b>	Application for entering contest, registered at the University of Oradea, signed by the candidate, accompanied by a statement on his own responsibility concerning the veracity of the information submitted in the file – standard sheet.
	The candidate's CV, both printed and in electronic format, according to the Methodology framework with the subsequent changes and additions, Art. 14.
	The candidate's list of works, both printed in electronic format, according to the Methodology framework with the subsequent changes and additions, Art. 15.
	A statement verifying the fulfillment of standards for applying for / obtaining the position according to the valid minimal standards.
	Certified PhD copy and, if the original PhD was obtained abroad, the certificate for its recognition or equivalence in Romania.
	Copies of other diplomas certifying the candidate's studies: highschool graduation degree or certificate of recognition, Bachelor Degree or certificate of recognition, Master's Degree or certificate of recognition – original documents will be provided for compliance .
	Regimental rolls, diploma supplements or school situations issued for each cycle of studies – original documents will be provided for compliance.
	A copy of the candidate's ID card, or passport, or of another identification document equivalent of and ID card or passport.
	If the candidate has changed name, copies of documents certifying the name change – marriage certificate or proof of the name

	Medical certificate attesting his ability of carrying out a teaching activity.
	A personal statement of the candidate that they are not in any circumstances of incompatibility laid down in the Law 1/2011 (The National Education Law) and the Framework Methodology issued at national level, with its subsequent additions and changes – standard sheet.
	A PhD Thesis summary of maximum one page, in Romanian and English.
	A maximum of 10 publications, patents or other works of the candidate, in electronic format, which he has selected and considered to be the most relevant to his professional achievements.
	List of referees for the position of full University Professor.
	The candidate's proposal for his further academic career development, both from the point of view of teaching activities as well as the scientific research activities, in the case of the faculties which require this public lecture as a test.

Comission	<b>The commission members are selected from the existing members or a new commission is appointed. The contest commission is formed of 5 members, including its <u>chairman</u>, specialists in the field of the vacant position or in related fields. The contest commission may also include substitute members.</b>
Methodology	<b>Files with doc, docx or PDF extensions are to be uploaded. The maximum size of a file accepted is 10MB.</b>

All the added positions will have an “upcoming” status until a representative of the minister will approve their posting on the main page of the site.
