Description of contest procedure	Own methodology of contest for the didactic and research positions available at the University of Oradea stipulates:  *Art. 25 For the position of Associate Professor or Scientific Researcher Grade II, the candidates, graduates of accredited higher education institutions must meet all of the following conditions:  • to hold a PhD diploma;  • to meet the national minimum standards for occupying the academic positions specific to the academic rank of Associate Professor, approved by the order of the Minister of Education, Research, Youth and Sports.  • other criteria specific to each faculty / department / center set in the own methodology approved by the University Senate, criteria that cannot fall below the national minimum standards approved by the Minister of Education, Research, Youth and Sports.  *Art. 27 (1) The contest for the position of Associate Professor - Scientific Researcher Grade II and University Professor or Scientific Researcher Grade I consists in the analysis of the contest file and a public lecture.  (2) The public lecture is of at least 45 minutes, where the candidate presents the most significant results of
