COMPETITION PROCEDURE

FOR PERMANENT EMPLOYMENT OF VACANT TEACHING AND RESEARCH POSTS FACULTY OF HISTORY, INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS, POLITICAL SCIENCE AND COMMUNICATION SCIENCES

The procedure was approved at the Senate meeting on

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I. GENERAL ASPECTS

Art. 1.

At the Faculty of History, International Relations, Political Sciences and Communication Sciences, Departments of International Relations and European Studies, respectively Political Sciences and Communication Sciences, vacant teaching or research posts are filled for an indefinite period only through *open competition*, under:

- Law No 199/2023;
- GD 1339/2023 on the approval of the Framework Methodology for the competition to fill teaching and research vacancies in higher education;
- OM 6129/2016 on the approval of the minimum necessary and mandatory standards for the award of teaching titles in higher education, professional degrees in research and development, the quality of doctoral supervisor, and the habilitation certificate;
- Specific standards on the external assessment of academic quality for bachelor and master degree programs related to the specialized committees, approved by the ARACIS Council;
- Own competition methodology for filling vacant teaching and research posts at the University of Oradea, approved by the University Senate;
- The University of Oradea's Senate has approved the criteria for the competition for teaching vacancies;
 - the present procedure for filling vacant posts by competition for an indefinite period;
 - other legislation in force at the time of the competition.

Art. 2. The teaching posts are put out to competition and candidates are enrolled.

- **2.1.** At the Faculty of History, International Relations, Political Science and Communication Sciences (IRISPSC), teaching and research posts in the fundamental fields *Humanities and Arts* and *Social Sciences*, subfields History, Political Science, Communication Sciences, Security Studies International Relations and European Studies, vacancies in the Staff Regulations of the three departments (History, DRISE and DSPSC), approved by the Senate of the University of Oradea, according to their development strategy and in compliance with the ARACIS standards regarding the filling of teaching posts with tenured professors.
- **2.2.** Vacancies are proposed by the director of the department/doctoral school in which the vacancy is located, through a report endorsed by the Department Council/Doctoral School Council and the Faculty Council.
- **2.3.** The list of positions proposed for filling by public competition is endorsed by the Faculty Council, approved by the Dean, and submitted to the UO Board of Directors for approval, according to art. 139, letter d) of the Law on Higher Education no. 199/2023.
- **2.4.** The University of Oradea publishes competitions for vacant teaching and research posts based on *its Methodology for the* public announcement of *competitions for vacant teaching and research posts* and the *Calendar of the competitions for vacant posts published in the Official Gazette*.
- **2.5.** Registration for the competition for vacant teaching positions is realized by submitting the application file to the Department of Human Resources of the University of Oradea. The application file must be drawn up under the *List of documents required for applying for the competition and the criteria for filling the teaching positions* set out in the University of Oradea's *Methodology for the competition for vacant teaching and research posts*.

PREPARATION OF DEPARTMENTAL COMPETITIONS

Art. 3. The Department Directors will submit to the Faculty Council the committees proposed by the Department Council for the conduct of the job competitions. These proposals will be centralized and approved in the Faculty Council meeting. The nominal composition of the competition committee, together with the opinion of the Faculty Council, shall be submitted to the University Senate and submitted to for its approval. Following approval by the University Senate, the competition committee is appointed by decision of the Rector.

Art. 4. Commission

- **4.1.** The composition of the selection board is determined after publication of the vacancy notice for each post advertised.
- **4.2. The** competition committee is composed of 5 members, including its chairperson, specialists in the field of the disciplines of the post advertised or in related fields. The composition of the selection board includes a minimum of two alternate members (one of whom must be from outside the UO, for the posts of professor or lecturer). If a member is unable to take part in the work of the board, he/she will be replaced by the alternate member appointed by the same procedure as the members of the board.
- **4.3.** Decisions of the selection board are taken by open vote of its members. A decision of the committee is valid if at least 3 members of the committee vote in favor of it.
- **4.4.** The work of the selection board is conducted by the chairperson.
- **4.5.** The members of the committee may be from inside or outside the UO, from home or abroad.
- **4.6.** To fill a post of university lecturer, university professor, scientific researcher grade I or scientific researcher grade II, at least 3 members of the committee must be from outside the UO, from the country or abroad.
- **4.7. The** members of the competition committee must have a teaching or research title higher than or at least equal to that of the teaching/research position corresponding to the post advertised or, for members from abroad, meet the minimum standards corresponding to the teaching/research position corresponding to the post advertised.
- **4.8.** For the exclusive purpose of participation in the competition committee, the teaching or research titles of the foreign members will be equated with the teaching or research titles in the country, based on which the university senate approves the nominal composition of the competition committee.
- **4.9 The** chairman of the selection board may be:
 - a) the head of the department or head of the doctoral school in which the post is located;
 - b) the dean or vice-dean of the faculty where the post is located;
 - c) a tenured UO teacher, a specialist in the field of the disciplines of the position or in a related field, delegated for this purpose by a vote of the department council, respectively of the faculty council organizing the competition.
- **4.10.** When appointing the chair of the selection board, an alternate chair (who may also act as an alternate member of the selection board) will also be appointed.

II. REGISTER FOR THE COMPETITION

To apply for the competition, candidates must meet the following minimum requirements and standards:

5.1. For the position of university assistant or research assistant are required cumulatively:

- a) hold a doctoral degree or be enrolled in a doctoral degree program, without exceeding the maximum period of study, which includes extensions admissible by law;
- b) publication of at least 1 paper (article, study), in extenso, in specialized journals or in volumes of national or international scientific events;
- c) other specific additional standards set out in Annexes 3.1 and 3.2 (as appropriate).

5.2. For the position of lecturer or scientific researcher grade III are required cumulatively:

- a) hold a doctorate:
- b) publication of at least 5 papers (articles, studies), in extenso, in specialized journals or in volumes of national or international scientific events;
- c) the development, at least in electronic form, of specialized teaching material, posted on the UO e-learning platform (e.uoradea.ro), in the field of the disciplines of the post, or a specialized book, in the field of the post;
- d) other additional standards, set out in Annexes 3.1 and 3.2 (as appropriate).

5.3. For the post of university lecturer or scientific researcher grade II are required cumulatively:

- a) hold a doctorate;
- b) fulfillment of the national minimum standards for the position of university lecturer, standards

- approved according to art. 156 of the Law on Higher Education no. 199/2023;
- e) other additional standards, set out in Annexes 3.3 and 3.4 (as appropriate).
- **5.4.** The following cumulative conditions must be fulfilled **for the post of university professor or scientific researcher grade I**:
 - a) hold a doctorate:
 - b) to hold the certificate of competence;
 - c) fulfilling the minimum standards for the position of university professor, standards approved according to art. 156 of the Law on Higher Education no. 199/2023;
 - f) other additional standards, set out in Annexes 3.3 and 3.4 (as appropriate).

DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO APPLY FOR THE COMPETITION

- **Art.6**. Î.The application for the competition to fill teaching positions in the Departments of History, International Relations and European Studies, respectively Political Sciences and Communication Sciences, is carried out according to the provisions of the *Methodology of the competition for filling vacant teaching and research positions at the University of Oradea*, by submitting the application file to the Human Resources Department of the University of Oradea, directly or through postal or courier services that allow confirmation of receipt.
- **Art. 7**. The application file is constituted by the candidate and will include the sheets to verify the fulfillment of the national minimum standards of the University of Oradea, the specific requirements and criteria (Annexes 3.5, 3.6, 3.7, 3.8, as appropriate).
- **Art. 8.** The competition file must be submitted in both paper and electronic format, with its entire contents scanned. The list of papers, the curriculum vitae and the check sheet must be scanned as separate files, together not exceeding 10 MB. The scanned documents will not contain any personal data of the candidate (photograph, National Identity Card, home address, signature, etc.).
- **Art. 9.** The fulfillment by a candidate of the legal requirements for admission to the competition is certified by the opinion of the legal department of the U.O.

III. RUNNING THE COMPETITION

- **Art. 10.** The selection board evaluates candidates for the competition for the posts from the following criteria:
 - a) the relevance and impact of the candidate's scientific results;
 - b) the candidate's ability to mentor students or young researchers;
 - c) the candidate's teaching skills;
 - d) the ability of the candidate to transfer his/her knowledge and results to the economic or social environment or to popularize his/her scientific results;
 - (e) the candidate's ability to work in a team and the effectiveness of his/her scientific collaborations, depending on the specific field of the post;
 - f) the candidate's ability to conduct research and development projects;
 - g) professional experience in institutions other than the University of Oradea.
- **Art. 11.** In the case where the position in question is that of assistant/head of studies/university reader, the competition committee is obliged to verify and ascertain, from the point of view of didactic and scientific relevance, the fulfillment of the standards for the occupation of teaching positions, specific to the position, approved by the university senate, according to the law.
- **Art. 12.** If the post concerned is that of university lecturer/professor, the competition committee is obliged to verify and ascertain whether the candidate fulfills the minimum standards and additional requirements in terms of teaching relevance and scientific relevance. The minimum standards and additional requirements may not deviate from the national minimum standards approved under Art. 156 para. (1) lit. a) of the Law on Higher Education No. 199/2023, as amended.
- **Art. 13.** The candidate's professional competences are assessed by the selection board based on the competition file and, additionally, through the following tests:

13.1 Competition to fill the post of <u>university assistant/research assistant</u> consists of a written test and a practical test (seminar, laboratory). The subject of the practical test is set by the chair of the selection board, in consultation with the members of the selection board, and is announced at least 3 working days before the test on the competition website, together with the date, time and place of the competition, inviting all candidates to the tests.

The calculation of the marks awarded after examining the candidate's application file is based on the indicators set out in the grid for the evaluation of candidates (Annex 3.1 or 3.2, as appropriate).

- 13.2 For the posts of university lecturer or scientific researcher grade III, university lecturer/scientific researcher grade II, and university professor/scientific researcher grade I, the competition tests are:
- (a) The didactic lecture this test necessarily includes a session of questions from the committee. The subject of the didactic lecture is set by the chair of the selection board, in consultation with the members of the selection board, and is announced at least 3 working days before the test on the competition website, together with the date, time and place of the competition, inviting all candidates to the tests. The oral test will be marked out of 10, with 2 decimal places allowed.
- (b) The *academic career development lecture*, in which the candidate presents his/her most significant previous professional achievements and *academic career development plan*. This examination must also include *a question session*. The presentation of the lecture will be marked out of 10 with 2 decimals allowed.

The calculation of the marks awarded after the analysis of the candidate's application file is based on the indicators set out in the grid for the evaluation of candidates (Annex 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, or 3.4, as appropriate).

Art. 14.

- **14.1** For each post, the selection board decides on the ranking of candidates and nominates the candidate with the best results.
- **14.2.** The chairman of the selection board draws up a report (Annex 5) on the competition based on the assessment reports (Annex 4.1 or Annex 4.2, as appropriate) drawn up by each member of the selection board, respecting the ranking of candidates decided by the board.
- **14.3**. The competition report is approved by a decision of the competition committee and is signed by each member of the competition committee and by the chairperson of the committee.
- **14.4.** The result of the competition will be published, within 2 working days after the finalization of the competition, on the UO website.
- **14.5.** The president of the competition committee forwards the report, approved by the decision of the committee, evaluation reports, and the original file of the candidate to the faculty/department/center management, respecting the deadline set for the competition.
- **14.6.** The candidate may appeal, within 3 working days from the communication of the result, in writing and registered at the UO Registrar's Office. The appeal shall be dealt with by a specially appointed committee, which may not include members of the selection board.
- **Art.15.** The present procedure complements specific standards for the areas managed by the Faculty, the *own Methodology of competition for filling vacant teaching and research posts at the University of Oradea*, approved by the UO Senate and comes into force from the date of its approval by the University Senate.

- The books, volumes or dictionaries taken into account are those published by publishers with international prestige (category A1), or publishers with recognized prestige (category A2), or which are present in at least 6 libraries in Worldcat.
- The following languages are considered to be languages of international circulation: English, French, German, Italian, Spanish and German.
- For certain categories of publications (see grid below), the multiplication coefficient *m* is applied, which has the following values: 2 if the publication was published by a foreign publisher with international *peer review* and is written in a language in international circulation; 1.5 if the publication is written in a language in international circulation but was not published by a foreign publisher with international *peer review*; 1 in all other cases.
- Recognized international databases are ISI Web of Knowledge, SCOPUS, EBSCO, ProQuest, CEEOL, Ulrich, ERIH, Index Copernicus, CSA, GESIS, IBSS, SAGE, OVID, ECOLIT, Psychlit, PubMed, Elsevier, Springerlink, Perseus, DOAJ, Jstor, SSRN, REPEC, Informa, Project MUSE, HEIN Online.
- $\triangleright n$ indicates the number of authors of a publication for which the candidate is author or co-author.
- For the category of articles published in ISI "ISI listed" journals, only those indexed in the ISI Web of Knowledge are taken into account, and it is mandatory to report the registration code of the article (WOS). The impact factor, where available, is the one related to the year in which the article was published.¹
