

## 5. HOW TO GET TO ORADEA

The easiest way to get to Oradea is to get to Budapest, from where you can take the train or the bus to Oradea.

For bus – [www.autogari.ro](http://www.autogari.ro) (this web site does not have an English version, but it is really easy to use). From Timișoara to Oradea there are 10 trips daily, and from Cluj one daily. The one-way ticket from Timișoara or Cluj costs about 10 euro.
