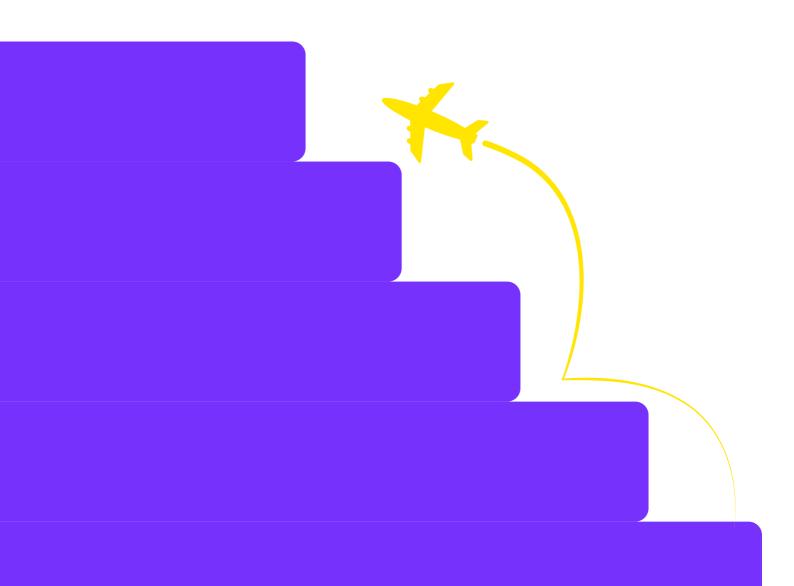




Steps for Incoming Erasmus Students

- Accommodation



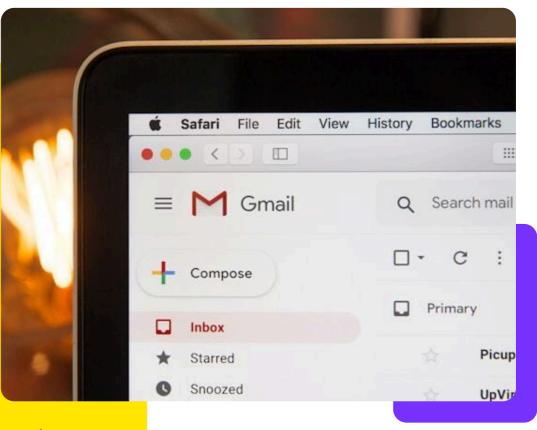
Nomination and Application

 After you have been nominated by your home institution, you will receive an email from us with the application procedure and a list of <u>required documents</u>.

Deadlines for submitting the application forms:

• Full year or 1st semester: June 30

2nd semester: November 30

Learning Agreement

- If you are using the Online Learning Agreement (OLA)
 via the Erasmus Without Paper (EWP) dashboard, there
 is no need to send the Learning Agreement by email.
 Simply mention in your email that we can find your
 Learning Agreement on the EWP dashboard.
- The Learning Agreement must be signed by your departmental coordinator.
- For OLA users, please make sure you list the correct person as the receiving institution's coordinator.
- If you come for one semester only, be sure to select the appropriate courses for the correct semester (Autumn or Spring).



Letter of Confirmation

- Once you have submitted the required documents and your Learning Agreement has been signed by the departmental coordinator, you will receive your official Letter of Confirmation from the University of Oradea.
- Please allow us some time to process your documents.



Financial Agreement

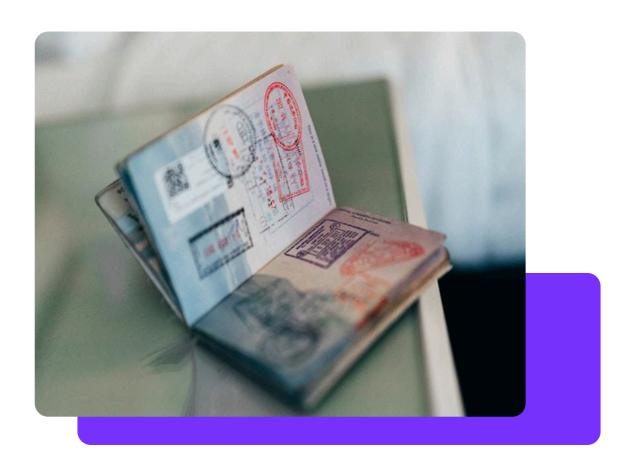
 Coordinate with your sending (home) institution to prepare and sign your Erasmus+ Financial Agreement.

Visa Requirements (for Non-EU Students)

- Apply for your student visa in a timely manner, according to your country's regulations.
- Note: The Erasmus Office does not issue separate
 accommodation documents. However, the Letter of
 Confirmation includes a section about
 accommodation, which should be sufficient for your
 visa application.



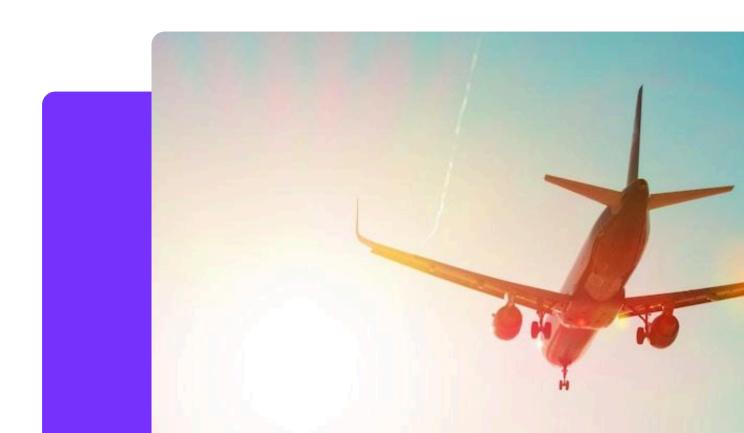
Accommodation

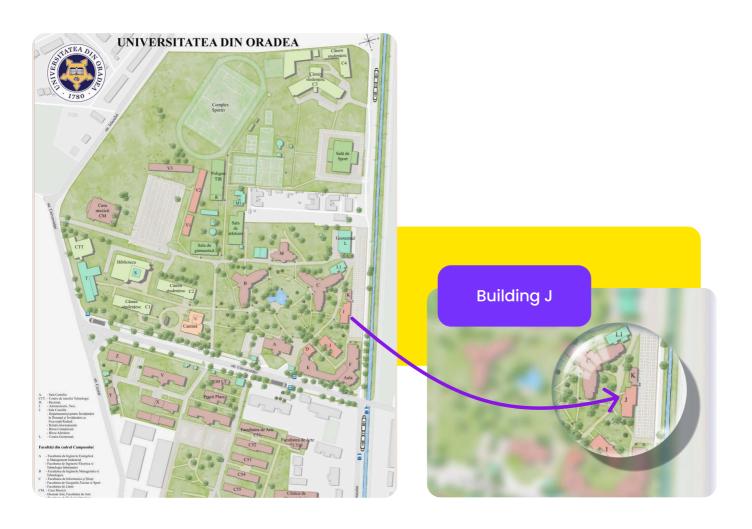

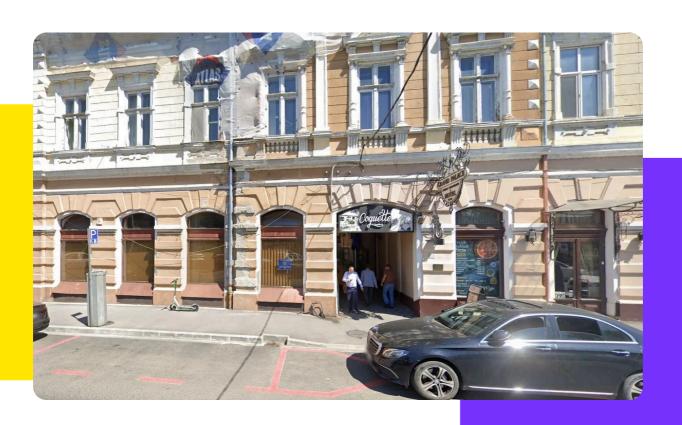
Meet Your Departmental Coordinator

- Schedule a meeting with your departmental coordinator.
- Meet all of your professors and make sure to set some clear expectations with them (discuss the course content, evaluation criteria, and important deadlines)
- For any changes in your Learning Agreement, the coordinator must approve and sign the updated document.



Non-EU Students Only

- Apply for a residence permit.
- Schedule an appointment with the <u>Immigration Office</u>.

· Attend lectures and get involved in your academic activities.



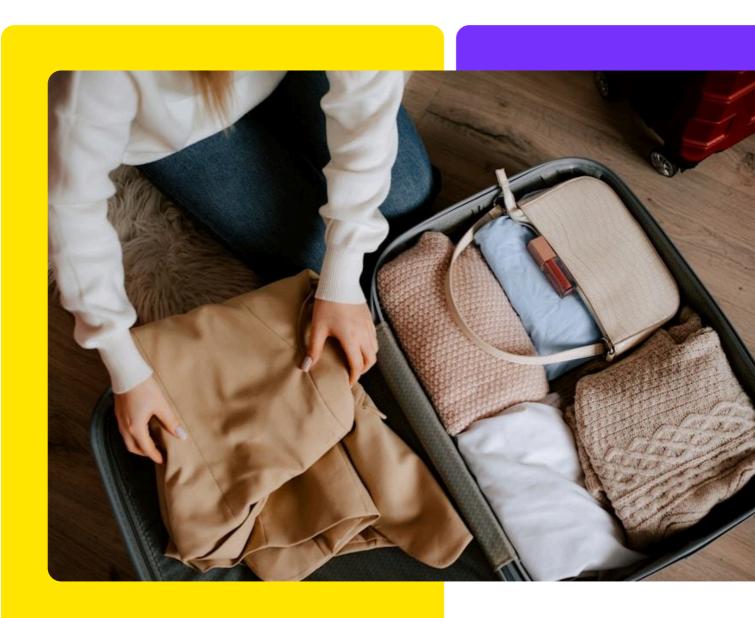
Join Erasmus Activities
