Obiective - valorificarea resurselor umane care lucrează în domenii diferite ale psihologiei; - susținerea interesului pentru cercetarea aplicativă în domeniul psihologiei; - promovarea rezultatelor cercetării științifice pe plan național și internațional; - valorificarea rezultatelor cercetării prin implementarea unor programe de prevenție, intervenție sau consultanță psihologică; - dezvoltarea capacității de interrelaționare, de colaborare în scopul atingerii obiectivelor propuse la nivel de colectiv de cercetare; - propunerea și derularea unor teme/proiecte de cercetare de interes major pentru diverși beneficiari (învățământ, sănătate, organizații); - promovarea și susținerea unor programe de formare inițială (masterat) sau continuă (cursuri, training-uri etc.); - acordarea de asistență și consultanță psihologică celor interesați de domeniu; - sprijinirea publicării de articole/studii elaborate de membrii Centrului de Cercetare în scopul popularizării acestuia; - administrarea unor instrumente psihologice în scopul validării/etalonării acestora pe populație românească; - organizarea de întâlniri (conferințe, dezbateri) pe teme de interes pentru activitatea centrului; - perfecționarea deprinderilor de cercetare ale tinerilor doctoranzi sau masteranzi incluși în diverse proiecte de cercetare; - susținerea modelului "practician-om de știință" în pregătirea viitorilor psihologi; - promovarea statutului profesiei de psiholog în diverse domenii. 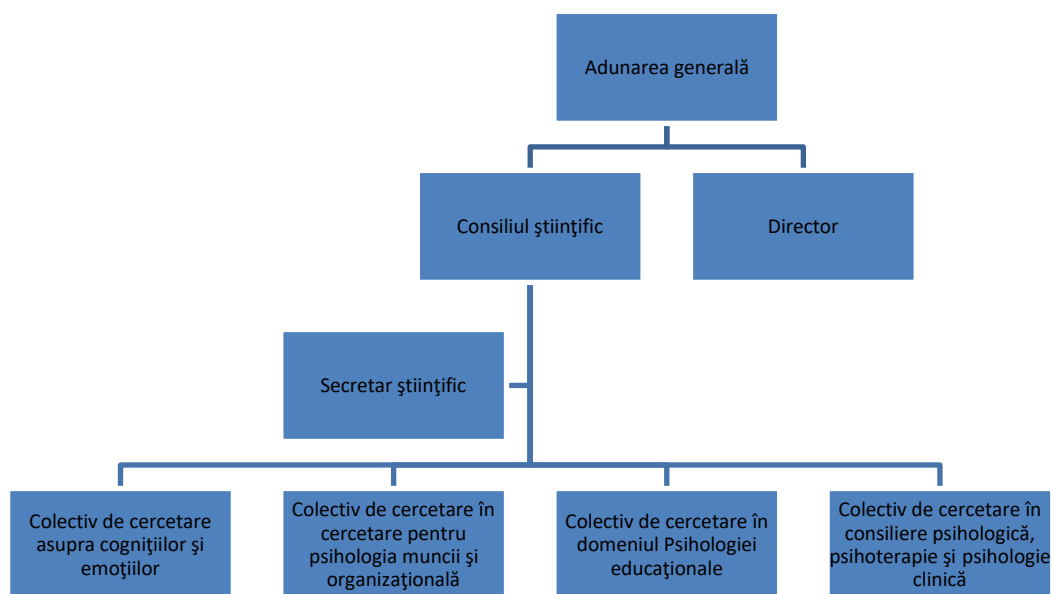
