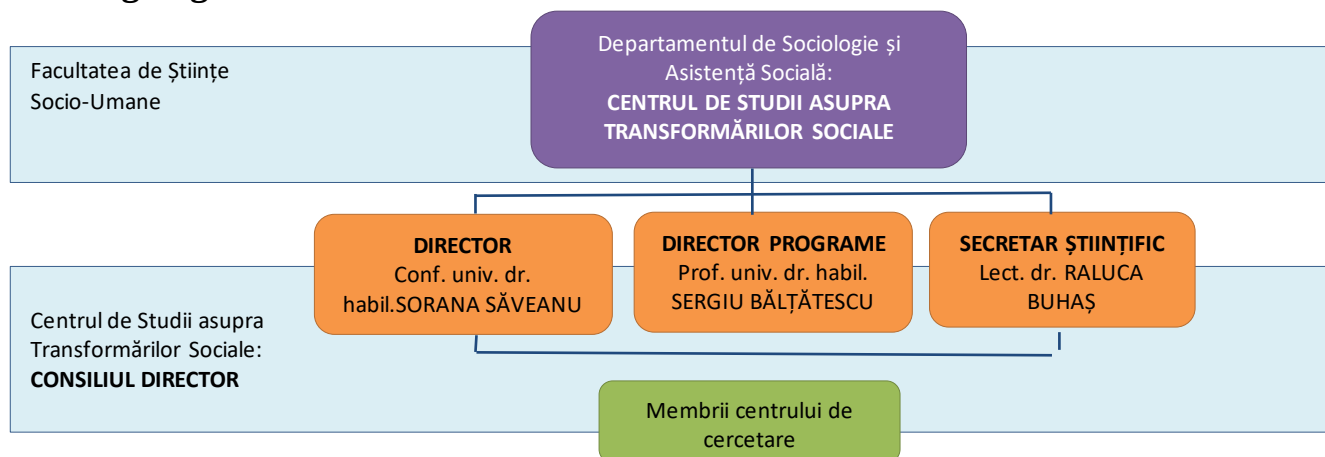

Pentru buna derulare a activității sale, centrul va uza de mijloace precum:

- donații, finanțări și sponsorizări, în lei și în valută de la persoane fizice sau juridice române sau straine;
- donații de bunuri materiale necesare și utile centrului de cercetare, primite de la persoane fizice sau juridice române sau străine;
- activități de autofinanțare derulate de către colectivul centrului în conformitate cu obiectivele generale ale centrului;
- mijloace proprii ale centrului de cercetare obținute din activitățile desfășurate conform legii, având ca scop obținerea de fonduri pentru centrul de cercetare.

7. Reglementări financiare

Resursele Centrului de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale vor fi alocate, cu respectarea dispozițiilor legale în vigoare, putând include următoarele tipuri de cheltuieli:

- pentru dezvoltarea bazei materiale proprii;
- taxe pentru participare la manifestări cultural-științifice;
- editarea de publicații, studii sau alte materiale în conformitate cu obiectivele centrului;
- acoperirea cheltuielilor de organizare și funcționare a centrului de cercetare;
- sau orice alte cheltuieli necesare bunei desfășurări a activității centrului de cercetare.

Veniturile, bunurile imobile și mobile ce vor fi dobândite în cadrul activităților inițiate, în conformitate cu prevederile legale, se constituie în patrimoniu al Centrului de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale servind la realizarea obiectivelor.

8. Dispoziții finale

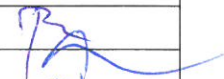
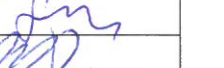
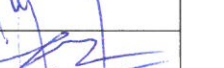
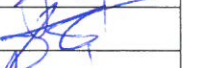
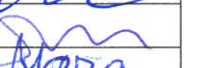
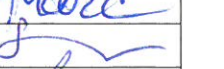
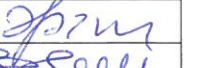
